GOSPEL Luke 18:9-14

At that time, Jesus spoke this parable also to some who trusted in themselves as just and despised others. "Two men went up into the temple to pray: the one a Pharisee and the other a publican. The Pharisee standing, prayed thus with himself: 'O God, I give thee thanks that I am not as the rest of men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, as also is this publican. I fast twice in a week: I give tithes of all that I possess.' And the publican, standing afar off, would not so much as lift up his eyes towards heaven; but struck his breast, saying: 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.' I say to you, this man went down into his house justified rather than the other: because everyone that exalts himself shall be humbled: and he that humbles himself shall be exalted."

One of the most popular Marian devotions in the Catholic Church today is that of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, often honored alongside the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion has its roots in Sacred Scripture, which makes frequent mention of Mary's contemplative heart, for example in Luke 2:19:

“But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart.”

According to Catholic doctrine, Mary is the Immaculate Conception; that is, in preparation for the Incarnation of the Second Person of the Holy Trinity in her womb, Mary was conceived without the corruption of original sin, and was preserved from committing any actual sins throughout the course of her life through the infinite merits of her Son, Jesus Christ. She was virginal not only of soul, but also of body, both before and after giving birth to Our Lord.

Our Lady was created actually “Full of Grace” as the Archangel Gabriel declared at the Annunciation, meaning that her soul was literally adorned with all of the virtues at the moment of her conception, as well as the gifts and fruits of the Holy Ghost. This fullness of grace is said to emanate from the center of her being, that is, her heart, understood both physically and spiritually. It is Mary's heart, in its unspoiled created perfection, that is the source and wellspring of her purity . . . therefore her heart is called Immaculate. Our Lord took his sacred humanity from the flesh and blood of his Blessed Mother; Christ's heart is taken from her heart. At Calvary, the perfect hearts of Jesus and Mary were united for the salvation of mankind. And this is why the Two Hearts are honored together.

While the Sacred Heart of Jesus is the source of Christ's burning love for humanity and is largely spurned by the indifference of mankind towards Him, the Immaculate Heart of Mary is the source of Our Lady's burning love for God and her desire to bring souls to her Son and is so often outraged by the offenses of mankind committed against her love.

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

THE ANTICHRIST AND OUR TIMES II

The first place to start in understanding who the Antichrist is would be to consult what the Bible has to say about him. The word "Antichrist" occurs only in the Epistles of the beloved St. John the Evangelist — he writes in this way:

Dear children, it is the last hour; and you have heard that Antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have arisen; whence we know that it is the last hour. They have gone forth from us, but they were not of us. For if they had been of us, they would surely have continued with us; but they were to be made manifest, that not one of them is of us... He is the Antichrist who denies the Father and the Son... And every spirit that severs Jesus is not of God, but is of Antichrist, of whom you have heard that he is coming and now is already in the world... For many deceivers have gone forth into the world who do not confess Jesus as the Christ coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the Antichrist.

St. John under the Inspiration of the Holy Ghost makes the following assertions:

- [1] "it is the last hour" — this means the Christian era — not necessarily the time just preceding the Second Coming.
- [2] St. John makes a distinction between "Antichrist" and "antichrists." It could be said this is the difference between the "spirit of antichrist" and the Antichrist himself.
- [3] As discussed last week, the Apostle identifies Antichrist and his minions as "deceivers." This is an important point.
- [4] The Antichrist's distinguishing characteristic is that his deception involves not confessing "Jesus as the Christ coming in the flesh." In other words, all who deny the humanity and divinity of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Incarnation, are in some manner doing the work of Antichrist.

The figure of the "man of sin" as discussed by St. Paul is a reference to the Antichrist and is intimately related to the Great Apostasy:

Let no one deceive you in any way, for the Day of the Lord will not come unless the apostasy comes first, and the man of sin revealed, the son of perdition...

The term "apostasy," or "revolt" is an attempt to translate the Greek word "discessio" of which there is no exact meaning in English. The closest understanding seems to be a nuanced idea that society in general is falling apart. Yeats in his poem "The Second Coming" describes the time of Antichrist this way:

Things fall apart, the center cannot hold;
Mere anarchy is loosed upon this world,
The Blood-dimmed tide is loosed, and everywhere
The Ceremony of innocence is drowned;
The best lack all conviction, while the worst
Are full of passionate intensity
Surely some revelation is at hand;
Surely the Second Coming is at hand.


