

Little is known about St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist, except that he was born Levi, the son of Alpheus, and he was likely born in Galilee. He worked as a tax collector, which was a disliked profession during the time of Christ.

According to the Gospel, Matthew was working at a collection booth in Capernaum when Christ came to him and said, "Follow me." With this simple call, Matthew became a disciple of Christ.

From Matthew we know of the many doings of Christ and the message Christ spread of salvation for all people who come to God through Him. The Gospel

account of Matthew tells the same story as that found in the other three Gospels, so scholars are certain of its authenticity. His book is the first of the four Gospels in the New Testament.

Many years following the death of Christ, around 41 to 50 AD, Matthew wrote his gospel account. He wrote the book in Aramaic in the hope that his account would convince his fellow people that Jesus was the Messiah and that His kingdom had been fulfilled in a spiritual way. It was an important message at a time when almost everyone was expecting the return of a militant messiah brandishing a sword.

It is thought he departed for other lands to escape persecution sometime after 42 AD. According to various legends he fled to Parthia and Persia, or Ethiopia. Like 11 of the 12 apostles, St. Matthew is traditionally thought to have died as a martyr while preaching the Gospel. Saint Matthew is often depicted with one of the four living creatures of Revelation 4:7, which reads, "The first living creature was like a lion, the second like a bull, the third living creature had a human face, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle."

Matthew was a tax collector and is therefore the patron saint of bankers and accountants. The Church established St. Matthew's feast day as September 21st.

St. Matthew Prayer - O Glorious St. Matthew, in your Gospel you portray Jesus as the longed-for Messiah who fulfilled the Prophets of the Old Covenant and as the new Lawgiver who founded a Church of the New Covenant. Obtain for us the grace to see Jesus living in his Church and to follow his teachings in our lives on earth so that we may live forever with him in heaven.

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

THE ANTICHRIST AND OUR TIMES V

Last week we saw from the Apocalypse of St. John that the Black Beast he depicts in his vision is symbolic of Antichrist and the resulting global system he heads. This system is the result of Freemasonry operating in the shadows but manifesting itself in every aspect of human existence and culture throughout the world. More importantly to consider is the Beast that has "two horns like that of a lamb but spoke like a dragon." This entity is what has been called "ecclesiastical Freemasonry," the purpose of which is to "[destroy] Christ and His Church, building a new idol, namely a false Christ and a false church." It is important to note that the Beast like that of a Lamb receives its power from the Back Beast, namely Freemasonry. This has largely been accomplished in our time.

In addition to Antichrist, another figure of compelling interest that presents himself to us in the Apocalypse is the person of the "false prophet." Here are pertinent quotes from the Bible:

And the beast was taken, **and with him the false prophet**, who wrought signs before him, wherewith he seduced them who received the character of the beast, and who adored his image. These two were cast alive into the pool of fire, burning with brimstone. [Apoc. 19:20]

And the **false prophet** shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. [Apoc.20:10]

The false prophet becomes, then, an agent and functionary of the beast, namely the Antichrist.

Fr. E. Sylvester Berry writes in his book "The Apocalypse of St. John":

Satan will first attempt to destroy the power of the Papacy and bring about the downfall of the Church through heresies, schisms and persecutions that must surely follow...For this purpose he will raise up Antichrist **and his prophet** to lead the faithful into error and destroy those who remain steadfast.

The Church is ever in labor to bring forth children to eternal life. In the sad days here predicted the sorrows and pains of delivery shall be increased many fold. There is presented here an allusion to some particular son of the Church whose power and influence shall be such that Satan will seek his destruction at any cost. This person can be none other than the Pope to be elected in those days. The papacy will be attacked by all the powers of hell. In consequence the Church will suffer great trials and afflictions in securing a successor

upon the throne of St. Peter... The Church deprived of her chief pastor must seek sanctuary in solitude there to be guided by God Himself during those trying days... In those days the Church shall also find refuge and consolation in faithful souls, especially in the seclusion of religious life. [pp. 82-85, 2016 Edition]

Our divine Savior has a representative on earth in the person of the Pope...

Likewise, Antichrist will have his representative in the false prophet who will be endowed with the plentitude of satanic powers to deceive the nations...

As indicated by the resemblance to a lamb, the [false] prophet will probably set himself up in Rome as a sort of antipope during the vacancy of the papal throne...[pp. 91-92]

I find Fr. Berry's description of these events to be rather astounding, especially because he wrote in 1921, long before Vatican II and the election of John XXIII and his successors of infamous memory.
