



## Feast of Christ the King

**GOSPEL (St. John 18:33-37)** At that time, Pilate therefore went into the hall again and called Jesus and said to him: "Art Thou the King of the Jews?" Jesus answered: "Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or have others told it thee of Me?" Pilate answered: "Am I a Jew? Thy own nation and the chief priests have delivered Thee up to me. What hast Thou done?" Jesus answered: "My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would certainly strive that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now My kingdom is not from hence." Pilate therefore said to Him: "Art Thou a King then?" Jesus answered: "Thou sayest that I am a King. For this was I born, and for this came I into the world; that I should give testimony to the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth My voice."



### Feast of Christ the King

The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, commonly referred to as the Feast of Christ the King, is observed on the last Sunday of October.

Pope Pius XI instituted the Feast of Christ the King in his encyclical letter *Quas primas* of 1925, in response to growing secularism.

According to Cyril of Alexandria, "Christ has dominion over all creatures, ...by essence and by nature." His kingship is founded upon the hypostatic union. "...The Word of God, as consubstantial with the Father, has all things in common with him, and therefore has necessarily supreme and absolute dominion over all things created."

"From this it follows that to Christ angels and men are subject. Christ is also King by acquired, as well as by natural right, for he is our Redeemer. ...' We are no longer our own property, for Christ has purchased us "with a great price"; our very bodies are the "members of Christ." A third ground of sovereignty is that God bestowed upon Christ the nations of the world as His special possession and dominion. "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me." (Matthew 28:18)

The feast has an eschatological dimension pointing to the end of time when the kingdom of Jesus will be established in all its fullness to the ends of the earth. It also leads into Advent, when the Church commemorates the arrival of the newborn king.

## FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

By now I'm sure you have heard of Francis' interview with Eugenio Scalfari in which the interviewer stated that Bergoglio does not believe in Christ's divinity. As I write this column on October 18 there has been no explicit denial from Francis himself, and the Vatican has been rather evasive. I wonder how most Catholics, when and if they hear of this, react to such a thing. Does it matter to them—do most believe that Christ is God themselves—or are we at such a low ebb in the history of the Church that no one even cares anymore. If such is the case, this is even more disturbing than a putative "Pope" who manifests this most appalling apostasy. After all, if Our Lord Jesus Christ was not God Incarnate, then the whole of Catholic faith not only collapses, but becomes a cruel joke, an appalling parody.

There is little doubt in my mind that Francis does not believe in Christ's divinity. I say this because in my journey to the priesthood I studied in a number of "Schools of Theology." Among the worst was a place, now closed, called "The Washington Theological Union," in Washington, D.C. Some of us quipped the institution should have been renamed "The Hereticum." There was after all in Rome "The Angelicum," run by the Dominicans; or the "Gregorianum," run by the Jesuits, both of which, I'm sure had their theological problems. But The Hereticum shone above all the rest for its outstanding acceptance and expert promotion of heresy. It was widely recognized by the "Catholic" Establishment as one of the best places to study theology. This alone should have kept everyone with any faith remaining—far away from its portals.

The Hereticum was universally known to promote the "theology" of Karl Rahner; the darling of all heretical theologians, who had, among others, a profoundly malign influence at the "Second" Vatican Council. Rahner, Ratzinger, as well as many others were censured during the Pontificate of Pope Pius XII but rehabilitated under John XXIII. Rahner's foundational principle was:

### THEOLOGY IS ANTHROPOLOGY

Look carefully at that statement. The definition of theology is the study of the things of God. The definition of anthropology is the study of the thing concerning MAN. St. Thomas Aquinas, as well as all orthodox theologians commence their study of God with God and eventually lead to man. Modernist "theology" begins with man, and in all reality ends with man. "Theology is anthropology" leads to a total denial of the supernatural and makes man into a god himself without reference to the transcendent God, the God of Revelation. Routinely, in a Hereticum classroom you would hear the following emanate from the mouths of many—I'm paraphrasing but not exaggerating:

"Karl Rahner was my teacher — the greatest theologian of Vatican II — so I know what he thought. Forget about the ridiculous notion that Christ was God — he didn't rise from the dead, he didn't walk on water, he didn't heal anyone with miracles — he didn't start a church — this was all a fiction created by the early church...etc. If you don't believe this, I will call your Superior and tell them not to ordain you..."

In some quarters, at least two generations of priests were trained to think this way.

Without question, Francis Bergoglio adheres to this thinking as he takes Rahnerian theology for granted. From 1 John 4: 2-3a:

"By this is the spirit of God known. Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God; and every spirit that dissolveth Jesus, is not of God, AND THIS IS ANTICHRIST.

### DRESS POLICY




