



## Second Sunday in Lent

**GOSPEL Matt. 17:1-9** At that time, Jesus took Peter, James, and his brother John, and led them up a high mountain by themselves, and was transfigured before them. And His face shone as the sun: and His garments became white as snow. And behold there appeared to them Moses and Elias talking with Him. Then Peter addressed Jesus, saying, "Lord, it is good for us to be here: if You will, let us make here three tabernacles, one for Thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

And as He was yet speaking, behold a bright cloud overshadowed them. And lo a voice out of the cloud, saying: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased: hear Him." And the disciples hearing fell upon their faces and were very much afraid. And Jesus came and touched them: and said to them: "Arise, and fear not." And lifting up their eyes, saw no one, but only Jesus.

And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus cautioned them, saying: "Tell the vision to no man, till the Son of Man has risen from the dead."



We are told that angels have many roles. A few of them include being God's messengers and Holy warriors, watching history unfold, praising and worshipping God, and being Guardian Angels – protecting and directing people on God's behalf.

The Bible tells us that God's angels are delivering messages, accompanying the lonely, granting protection and even fighting His battles. Angels who were sent to deliver messages began by saying "Do not be afraid," or "Do not fear."

**The Angel Gabriel** is a messenger who was entrusted to deliver several important messages on God's behalf. Gabriel appears to at least three people in the Bible: first to the prophet

Daniel ([Daniel 8:16](#)); next to the priest Zechariah to foretell and announce the miraculous birth of John the Baptist ([Luke 1:19](#)); and finally to the virgin Mary to tell her that she would conceive and bear a son ([Luke 1:26–38](#)).

Gabriel's name means "God is great," and, as the angel of the annunciation, he is the one who revealed that the Savior was to be called "Jesus" ([Luke 1:31](#))

In all three appearances, Gabriel was met with fear, and he had to begin his conversations with words of comfort and cheer for Daniel, Zechariah, and Mary. It is possible that Gabriel was also the angel that appeared to Joseph in [Matthew 1:20](#), but this is not certain, since that angel is unnamed in Scripture. What we do know is that Gabriel is one of God's good and holy angels. He has a favored position as an angel who "stands in the presence of God" ([Luke 1:19](#)), and he was selected to deliver important messages of God's particular love and favor to individuals chosen to be part of God's plan.

The Angel Gabriel or Saint Gabriel's feast day was exclusively celebrated the 18th of March according to many sources dating between the years 1588 and 1921. The feast was included for the first time in the General Roman Calendar in 1921, for celebration on March 24th.


Saint Gabriel is the patron saint of messengers, those who work for broadcasting and telecommunications such as radio and television, postal workers, clerics and diplomats.

# The Ten Commandments were written by God upon two tablets of stone and given to Moses on Mount Sinai.

Most scholars date this event around the 13th or 14th century BC. God gave the Decalogue, or 10 Commandments, to the Israelites shortly after they left Egypt. The record of the Ten Commandments can be found in the Bible, both in Exodus 20:2-17 and Deuteronomy 5:6-21. *Douay-Rheims Bible*

**Exodus 20:1-17 And the Lord spoke all these words: I am the Lord thy God, who brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.**

- 1) Thou shalt not have strange gods before me.
- 2) Thou shalt not make to thyself a graven thing, nor the likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or in the earth beneath, nor of those things that are in the waters under the earth. Thou shalt not adore them, nor serve them: I am the Lord thy God, mighty, jealous, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me: And shewing mercy unto thousands to them that love me, and keep my commandments.
- 3) Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain: for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that shall take the name of the Lord his God in vain.
- 4) Remember that thou keep holy the sabbath day. Six days shalt thou labour, and shalt do all thy works. But on the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God: thou shalt do no work on it, thou nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy beast, nor the stranger that is within thy gates. For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, and the sea, and all things that are in them, and rested on the seventh day: therefore the Lord blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it.
- 5) Honour thy father and thy mother, that thou mayest be long lived upon the land which the Lord thy God will give thee.
- 6) Thou shalt not kill.
- 7) Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 8) Thou shalt not steal.
- 9) Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- 10) Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house: neither shalt thou desire his wife, nor his servant, nor his handmaid, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is his.
