And Jacob begot Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, Who is called Christ.

Saint Rose of Lima was born Isabel Flores de Olivia in the city of Lima, Peru on April 20, 1586. Her later nickname "Rose" comes from an incident in her infancy: a servant claimed to have seen her face transform into a rose.

In 1597 Isabel was confirmed and she formally took the name of Rose at that time.

As a young girl, in emulation of the noted Dominican tertiary Catherine of Siena, she began to fast three times a week and performed severe penances in secret. Despite the censure of her parents, she spent many hours contemplating the Blessed Sacrament, which she received daily, an extremely rare practice in that period. After daily fasting, she took to permanently abstaining from eating meat. She helped the sick and hungry around her community, bringing them to her room and taking care of them. Rose sold her fine needlework, and took flowers that she grew to market, to help her family. She made and sold lace and embroidery to care for the poor, and she prayed and did penance in a little grotto that she had built. Otherwise, she became a recluse, leaving her room only for her visits to church.

She attracted the attention of the friars of the Dominican Order. She wanted to become a nun, but her father forbade it, so she instead entered the Third Order of St. Dominic while living in her parents' home. In her twentieth year she donned the habit of a tertiary and took a vow of perpetual virginity. She only allowed herself to sleep two hours a night at most, so that she had more hours to devote to prayer. She donned a heavy crown made of silver, with small spikes on the inside, in emulation of the Crown of Thorns worn by Christ.

For eleven years she lived this way, with intervals of ecstasy, and eventually died on August 24, 1617, at the young age of 31. It is said that she prophesied the date of her death. Her funeral was held in the cathedral, attended by all the public authorities of Lima.

Her feast day is on August 30th. Saint Rose was a very selfless person and a very caring person even though most of her time she dedicated to the Lord.

Saint Rose was beatified by Pope Clement IX on May 10, 1667, and canonized on April 12, 1671, by Pope Clement X, the first Catholic in the Americas to be declared a saint. Her shrine, alongside those of her friends Martin de Porres and John Macias, is located inside the convent of Saint Dominic in Lima. The Catholic Church says that many miracles followed her death: there were stories that she had cured a leper, and that, at the time of her death, the city of Lima smelled like roses; roses also started falling from the sky. Many places in the New World are named Santa Rosa after her.

Saint Rose is the patroness of the Americas, especially of Lima, Peru, of Sittard in the Netherlands, of India, and of the Philippines, as well as embroiderers, gardeners, florists and people ridiculed or misunderstood for their piety and for the resolution of family quarrels.

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

THE ANTICHRIST AND OUR TIMES IV

Fr. Vincent Miceli, SJ, in his book entitled "The Antichrist-Has he launched his final campaign against the Savior?" writes on page 45:

The Christ is the Son of God sent by His Father as the Son of Man to redeem and sanctify men. The Antichrist is, in a metaphorical, spiritual sense, the true son of Satan sent by the Prince of Darkness to destroy and corrupt men. Christ is the suffering Servant of the Lord, obedient unto death, observing the Law of God and raising it to the perfection of the New Law of Love. The Antichrist, on the other hand, surpasses all others in hostility to God; he is the leader of a final revolt against God, "the man of sin," a kind of incarnation of the Arch-rebel Satan, "the man of lawlessness," "the son of perdition." Motivated by hatred of God and man, he opposes every aspect of true religion and takes his seat, as the abomination of desolation, in the holy place in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God. Christ is the Lamb of God who saves and nurtures the elect. The Antichrist is the **Beast of Satan**, the red dragon, **who with other beasts** makes plans and raises armies to persecute the faithful and mount the final conflict against the Church.

The Apocalypse speaks of "the Beast coming up from the Sea," or what might also be called "a beast like a leopard." This Beast could be seen as the person of the Antichrist, but could also be understood as symbolizing the whole assembly of the wicked and unfaithful, and most especially in recent centuries:

...the Black Beast (the Beast of the Sea) is **Freemasonry....**it acts in the shadow, keeps out of sight and hides himself in such a way as to enter in everywhere. He has the claws of a bear and the mouth of a lion, because he works everywhere with cunning and with the means of social communication, that is to say through propaganda. The seven heads indicate the various masonic lodges, which act everywhere in a subtle and dangerous way. This Black Beast has ten horns, and on the ten horns, ten crowns which are signs of dominion and royalty. (Fr. Stefano Gobbi, p 601)

However even more important for Traditional Catholics:

And I [John the Apostle] saw another Beast coming up out of the earth, and **it had two horns like those of a lamb, but it spoke like a dragon.** And it exercised all the authority of the former beast in its sight; and it made the earth and the inhabitants therein to worship the first Beast...[Apoc.13: 11-12]

At least two points can be made here:

[1] Freemasonry as symbolized by the Black Beast has taken over the world. This is indicated by the ten crowns it wears which has exercised dominion in every element of global society.

[2] The "Beast as a Lamb" indicates ecclesiastical Masonry whose purpose is that of **destroying Christ and His Church, building a new idol, namely a false Christ and a false church.** (ibid. p. 606) This Beast gains its power from Freemasonry as it "exercised all the authority of the former (Black Beast) in its sight."

DRESS POLICY
