Twenty First Sunday After Pentecost

GOSPEL Matt. 18:23-35 At that time, Jesus spoke to his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is likened to a king, who would take an account of his servants. And when he had begun to take the account, one was brought to him, that owed him ten thousand talents. And as he had not wherewith to pay it, his lord commanded that he should be sold, and his wife and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made. But that servant falling down, besought him, saying: 'Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.' And the lord of that servant being moved with pity, let him go and forgave him the debt.

"But when that servant was gone out, he found one of his fellow-servants that owed him a hundred pence: and laying hold of him, he throttled him, saying: 'Pay what thou owest.' And his fellow-servant falling down, besought him, saying: 'Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.' And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he paid the debt.

"Now his fellow servants seeing what was done, were very much grieved, and they came, and told their lord all that was done. Then his lord called him: and said to him: 'Thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all the debt, because thou besoughtest me: Shouldst not thou then have had compassion also on thy fellow servant, even as I had compassion on thee?' And his lord being angry, delivered him to the torturers until he paid all the debt. So also shall my heavenly Father do to you, if you forgive not everyone his brother from your hearts."



Lessons to be Learned from the Souls in Purgatory

To abhor sin: Especially willful, deliberate venial sin.

To shun the waste of time: Time is precious. It is given to us so that we may practice virtue and expiate sin. It should not be wasted in vain conversation, in fruitless reading, in aimless occupations.

To make satisfaction for sins: There is a temporary punishment attached to sin. Sin, even though forgiven, must be expiated. God's justice must be satisfied. How much easier it is to satisfy God's justice now by voluntary penance, than, later in the Purgatorial fires.

To be resigned to God's Will: To murmur, to find fault, to complain, is a sign of self-love. Love of self must be supplanted by the love of God. To bear up cheerfully, resignedly, under the cross, is a true act of love of God and will serve as an efficacious Purgatory on earth.

To avoid sensuality in little things: To abhor little faults of vanity, of dress, of conversation, of little self-indulgences, little gratifications in eating and drinking, little manifestations of pride. The soul that constantly seeks its own ease, its own comfort, the soul that is lazy, indifferent, slothful, that shirks all painful duties and lives only for self, must be purified before it is fit to be received into the presence of God.

To abhor unkindness in thought, word or deed: The soul that speaks evil of others, that judges them harshly, that wounds unnecessarily, that refuses to assist them, forgets the charity of Christ and prolongs the time of this separation from God.

The pious Catholic will permit the souls in Purgatory to teach him these truths and he will receive these teachings deep into the recess of his soul.

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

From the TRADITIO website:

On October 25, 2019, Francis-Bergoglio finally admitted publicly that the five idols rightly hurled into the Tiber River were "Pachamamas." Originally, he claimed that the images were of the (pregnant) Virgin Mary. Pachamama is the often-vengeful Mother Earth goddess of the Andean peoples. She is a pagan goddess... This means that worshippers in the Vatican Gardens on October 5, bowed in veneration of these idols, including a male figure *cum phallo erecto*. There is a photographic record that shows that Bergoglio imparted a "blessing" over one of these idols.

Few events have captured the attention of both the "religious" as well as the secular media in recent weeks than this occurrence during Francis' Amazon Synod, held this October in Rome. It is always interesting to see how certain Novus Ordo people loyal to Francis spin these events. One commentator stated: But this idol worship is done "without the intention of idolatry." One could just as easily say that adultery is done "without the intention of adultery." These are simply lies told to oneself and to the world at large. Almighty God, however, does not countenance lies and liars. From the Apocalypse, 21:8:

But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and IDOLATORS, AND ALL LIARS, they shall all have their portion in the pool burning with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

In reality, however, all of this is nothing new. John Paul II routinely engaged in pagan rituals. He was marked with the sign of Shiva, allowed a statue of the Buddha to be placed over a tabernacle at Assisi, kissed the Quran, etc.

Most especially, lest we forget:

Malachi Martin in his book "Windswept House" describes in this work: "The Enthronement of the Fallen Archangel Lucifer," [1963] where Satan himself in a double ceremony held simultaneously in Rome and Charleston, South Carolina was installed in the Vatican in an occult fashion. When asked by *The New American* magazine sometime later whether such an event actually took place Fr. Martin replied: "Oh yes, it is true; very much so. But the only way I could put it down into print was in novelistic form."

For centuries, Protestants have depicted the Great Harlot of the Apocalypse as the [Roman] Catholic Church, and Catholic theologians have had some difficulty with responding to such accusations. But in our time, this prophecy has become very clear. What is being described here is not the Church as Christ founded it, but the antichurch which has taken it over. The Harlot is described as someone "with whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication," she is "clothed with purple and scarlet and gilt with gold...having a golden cup in her hand," a clear allusion to a fallen hierarchy that wears purple and scarlet, with blasphemous liturgy in hand. The Fathers of the Church in the early centuries predicted that Rome would return to its ancient paganism, and we are witnessing this prodigy unfolding before our very eyes. The shenanigans of Bergoglio are simply a minor example of this Luciferian infection that occurred a long time ago. The Apocalypse admonishes us concerning this false church, the Great Harlot:

Go out from her, my people; that you be not partakers of her sins, and that you receive not of her plagues. (Chapter 18 vs. 4b)

DRESS POLICY




