SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

EPISTLE (1 Cor. 11:23-29) Brethren: I myself have received from the Lord (what I also delivered to you), that the Lord Jesus, on the night in which He was betrayed, took bread, and giving thanks broke, and said, "Take and eat. This is My body which shall be given up for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In like manner also the cup, after He had supped, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me. For as often as you shall eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord, until He comes." Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily, will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man prove himself, and so let him eat of that bread and drink of the cup; for he who eats and drinks unworthily, without distinguishing the body of the Lord, eats and drinks judgement to himself.



GOSPEL (John 6:56-59) At that time, Jesus said to the crowds of the Jews: "My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh, and drinks My blood, abides in Me and I in him. As the living Father has sent Me, and as I live because of the Father, so he who eats Me, he also shall live because of Me. This is the bread that has come down from heaven; not as your fathers at the manna, and died. He who eats this bread shall live forever."

Corpus Christi is the solemn commemoration of the institution of the Holy Eucharist. It is, moreover, the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ, who by instituting the Holy Eucharist gave to the Church her greatest treasure. Holy Thursday, assuredly, marks the anniversary of the institution, but the commemoration of the Lord's passion that very night suppresses the rejoicing proper to the occasion. Today's observance, therefore, accents the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday.

The Mass and the Office for the feast was edited or composed by St. Thomas Aquinas upon the request of Pope Urban IV in the year 1264. It is unquestionably a classic piece of liturgical work, wholly in accord with the best liturgical traditions. Monday, the Church commemorates the birth of St. John the Baptist, who was cleansed from original sin in his mother's womb and who consequently was holy at his birth. John is the only saint, besides the Blessed Virgin Mary, whose birth is celebrated, as all others were born in Original Sin.

Our Lady of Perpetual Help is celebrated on June 27th. The devotion to this Marian avocation revolves around the picture of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour, painted on wood, with background of gold. It is Byzantine in style and is supposed to have been painted in the thirteenth century. It represents the Mother of God holding the Divine Child while the Archangels Michael and Gabriel present Him the instruments of His Passion.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (Friday, June 28) is a reminder of all that we owe to the love of our Divine Redeemer. It is an appeal to our gratitude and it should prompt us to offer to the Divine Heart satisfaction and reparation for the numerous offenses of which we and others have been guilty. Appearing to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque during the Octave of Corpus Christi in the year 1675, Jesus said to her: "This is the heart which has loved men so much and in turn so little loved by them." Let us consecrate our good will to the Sacred Heart and offer to Him the sacrifice of a holy life. The celebration of the feast was extended to the general calendar of the Church by Pius IX in 1856.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, formed by the Holy Spirit in the womb of the Virgin Mary, have mercy on us.

FATHER SAFREED'S REFLECTIONS

JOHN XXIII VATICAN II AND THE "NEW PENTECOST" III

While grocery shopping at a Neighborhood Walmart recently, the front-end manager asked me what church I belonged to. As I was dressed as a priest, it would have been difficult at that moment to crawl under the nearest cash register and disavow any knowledge of matters theological. So, I told him: "Holy Family TRADITIONAL Catholic Church." Oh, he said, in subtle but biting condescension, "The SCHISMATIC church!" Well, well, I thought, this character obviously knows more than the average "catholic" so I shot back — "Oh no, YOU broke away from US." He didn't seem convinced, and went away wearing a morally superior attitude.

This is a situation the priest encounters, in one way or the other, all the time — attempting to explain something that comes with difficulty, it seems — even to those who call themselves Traditional Catholics, let alone to the many who have no clue about such things whatsoever. You simply can't have an intelligent discussion of very serious issues while checking out at Walmart. It is extremely frustrating, and becomes a great burden for everyone, but especially for priests of the Traditional variety. This is so because nothing can be taken for granted anymore.

Ah, and yes, we owe this terrible situation to the likes of Angelo Roncalli, antipope John XXIII, and his "New Pentecost." The destruction this man and his successors wrought with the disastrous effects of the "Second" Vatican Council cannot be overestimated, and the cancer it produced has metastasized for a period of at least 55 years. We, however, have been warned. Pope Leo XIII in 1890 predicted these events with "The Exorcism Prayer against Satan and the Apostate Angels." The quote below was omitted from most renderings of the prayer.

These most crafty enemies... have filled and inebriated with gall and have laid impious hands on her most sacred possessions. In the Holy Place itself where has been set up the See of the most holy Peter and the Chair of Truth for the light of the world, they have raised the throne of their abominable impiety, with the iniquitous design that when the Pastor has been struck, the sheep may be scattered.

And, shortly before he died, St. Francis of Assisi spoke to his brothers and followers warning them of coming troubles:

The devils will have unusual power, the immaculate purity of our Order, and of others, will be so much obscured that there will be very few Christians who will obey the [true] Roman Church with loyal hearts and perfect charity. **At that time of this tribulation a man, not canonically elected, will be raised to the Pontificate, who by his cunning, will endeavor to draw many into error and death.**

Almost without doubt, St. Francis is referring to John XXIII, who, as demonstrated last week, was not "canonically elected." The Saint continues:

Those who preserve their fervor and adhere to virtue with **love and zeal for truth, will suffer injuries and persecutions as rebels and SCHISMATICS**, for their persecutors, urged on by the evil spirits, will say they are rendering great service to God by destroying such pestilent men from the face of the earth.

From Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Gospel of St. Matthew:

Blessed are ye when they shall revile you, and persecute you, and speak all that is evil against you, untruly, for my sake: Be glad and rejoice, for your reward is very great in heaven. [Chap. 5, 11-12a]



Remember, also, Lord, Your servants and handmaids below who are gone hence before us, marked with the sign of faith, and sleep the sleep of peace. To them, Lord and to all that rest in Christ, grant, we implore You a place of happiness, light and peace through the same Christ our Lord. Amen
